

# JEWISH CHRISTIANITY: A SELECT BIBLIOGRAPHY

In recent years, the question of "Jewish Christianity" has crystallised about a problematic of its own, thanks to the pioneering literary works of H. J. Schoeps and J. Daniélou, and to the archaeological finds of B. Bagatti and E. Testa. The range of articles in last year's *Festschrift* dedicated to Daniélou and published in *Recherches de Science Religieuse* (1972) points to the scope of this problematic.

To help situate the questions surrounding and arising from the phenomenon labelled "Jewish Christianity", I had compiled the following bibliography for members of the Catholic Biblical Association (U.S.A.), who took part in a seminar dealing with the phenomenon at the August, 1973, meeting of the association. It is published here at the editor's request and with the author's awareness that though incomplete it is perhaps useful in opening up the problematic and in indicating the light the study may have to shed on the shadowy phases of the Christian movement in the period following the great Palestinian debacles of A.D. 70 and 135.
